

**Elkhorn Water District
CUSTOMER NOTICE**

Elkhorn Water District is providing customer notice that it has filed documents with the Public Service Commission to increase several nonrecurring charges (NRC) and the tap-on fee for a 1-Inch meter. The revised NRC's will apply to all Elkhorn Water District customers and the increased 1-inch meter tap-on fee will apply to any customer requesting the installation of a 1-Inch meter. The proposed effective date of the new charges is May 15, 2026. Current and proposed rates are as follows:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the Elkhorn District, but the PSC may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed NRC rates contained in this notice. Any person may submit comments regarding this tariff filing by mail at: Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602; or through its website at <http://psc.ky.gov>. Any person may submit a timely written request for intervention by mail at: Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing.
